what had happened to the stolen islanders had any survived slavery one day in 1863 a strange ship stopped at a tiny island in the wild seas between tonga and new zealand and sailed away with one hundred and forty four men women and children the atans were never heard from again and in tonga their fate became the subject of legends and superstitions uncovering the tragedy of ata takes scott hamilton on a journey to the kava circles and caves of tonga and back to the streets of auckland the stolen island is a twenty first century true sea story revealing slavers mutinies castaways pirates and a cruel streak in pacific history that is often overlooked but not forgotten

the great south road was built in 1862 to carry a british army into the waikato kingdom when the british invaded the waikato in 1863 soldiers shared the road with maori refugees from auckland today the eroding earthen walls of forts and pa and military cemeteries remember the road s history they sit beside the car dealerships and kava bars and pawn shops of south auckland the most culturally diverse part of the world s most culturally diverse city on their journeys up and down the great south road hamilton janman and powell have learned how the route s tragic past affects its present and discovered the ways in which the road connects as well as divides the communities that live alongside it ghost south road features obscure as well as famous figures from new zealand history and illustrates the epic walk that the author and photographers made along the two hundred kilometre length of the great south road

spanning nearly two centuries from first contact through to settlement and apology this major work focuses on the human impact of the war in the waikato its origins and aftermath

this book offers a sweeping history of pureora forest park one of the most significant sites of natural and cultural history interest in new zealand the authors review the geological history of the volcanic zone its flora and fauna and the history of maori and european utilization of forest resources chapter length discussions cover management of the native forest by the new zealand forest service the forest village and its sawmills the intensive timber harvesting and the conflicts with conservationists and expensive compensation agreements that ensued separate chapters cover initiatives to protect the forest from introduced herbivores to guard protected species especially birds from predators the facilities for recreational hunting the development of the timber trail an 83 km cycleway through the forest and along old logging tramways complete with detailed interpretation signs illustrating the history of logging and the family recreation areas and tracks the final chapter gathers conclusions and advances prospects for the future of pureora forest in sum the book demonstrates how ecological study combined with a respect for people and for nature plus a flexible interdisciplinary approach to both local history and current scientific priorities can be welded into a consistently effective strategy for addressing the pressing forest ecology questions of our time
